Summary

There are many aspects of the design. For non-commercial web sites, the goals may vary depending on the desired exposure and response. The basic aspects of the design document are:

- The content: the substance and information on the site should be relevant to the process of interviewing for a job. The site should target the area of the student population that the website is concerned with.
- The usability: the site should be user-friendly, with the interface and navigation simple and reliable.
- The appearance: the graphics and text should include a style that flows throughout, to show consistency. The style should be professional, appealing and relevant.
- The visibility: the site must also be easy to find via most, if not all, major search engines.

Storyboards will be used as graphic organizers such as a series of illustrations or images to be displayed in sequence for the purpose of pre-visualizing the website interactivity.

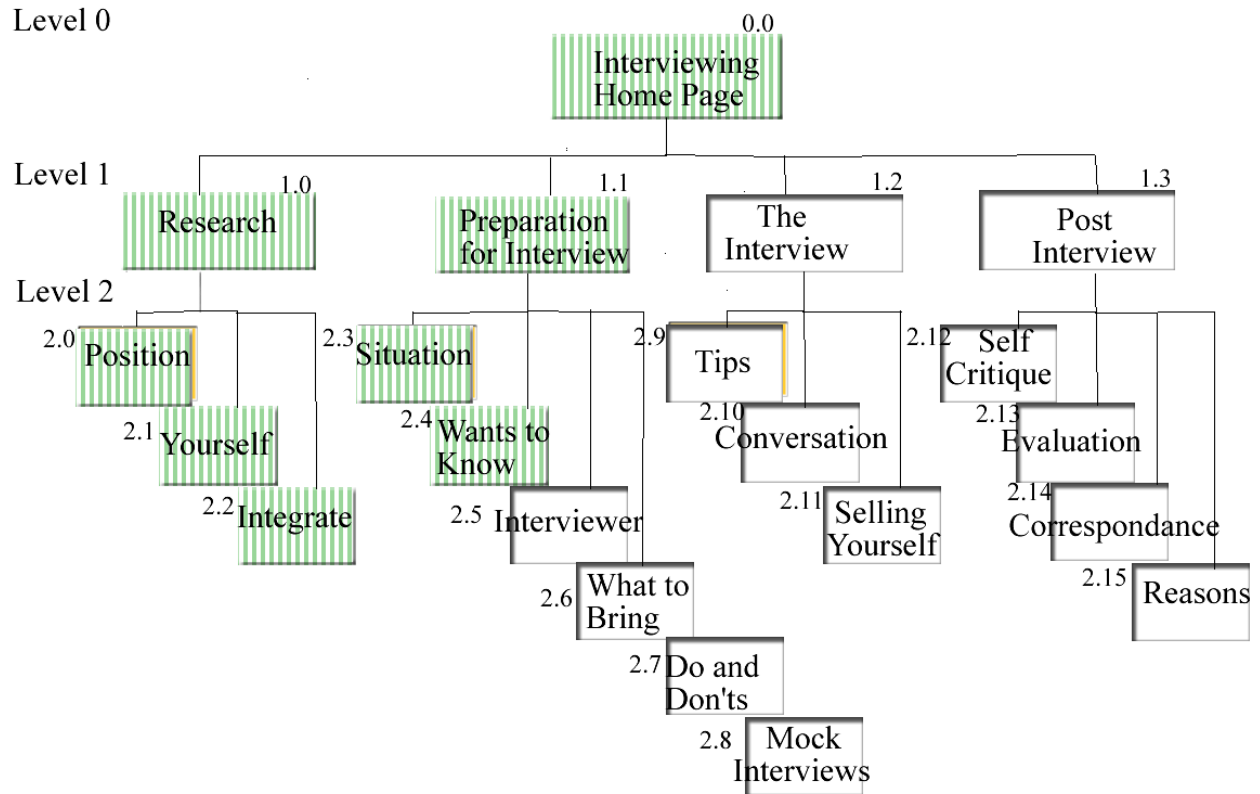
The Interview Website has 3 and possibly 4 levels of design.

- Level 0 (top) will be the Home page will have generic information about the different approaches to interviewing process and how it applies to the different fields the plan on entering.
- Level 1 will have the major topics of the Interviewing process that will guide the student through the process.
- Level 2 for each Level 1 topic will have information about the topic and collect information from the student
- Level 3 (not shown) will be utilized as needed to add flexibility to the design.

Pages are defined by the level number and then a sequentially number from left to right starting with "0". The Home page (Index.html) will be defined as 0.0 (top level, first page). The first page on the second level (research.html) will be defined as 1.0. The first page on the third level (position) would be 2.0 and so on.

The pages highlighted are the ones I am supplying as examples of my storyboarding for the 2.2 design document.

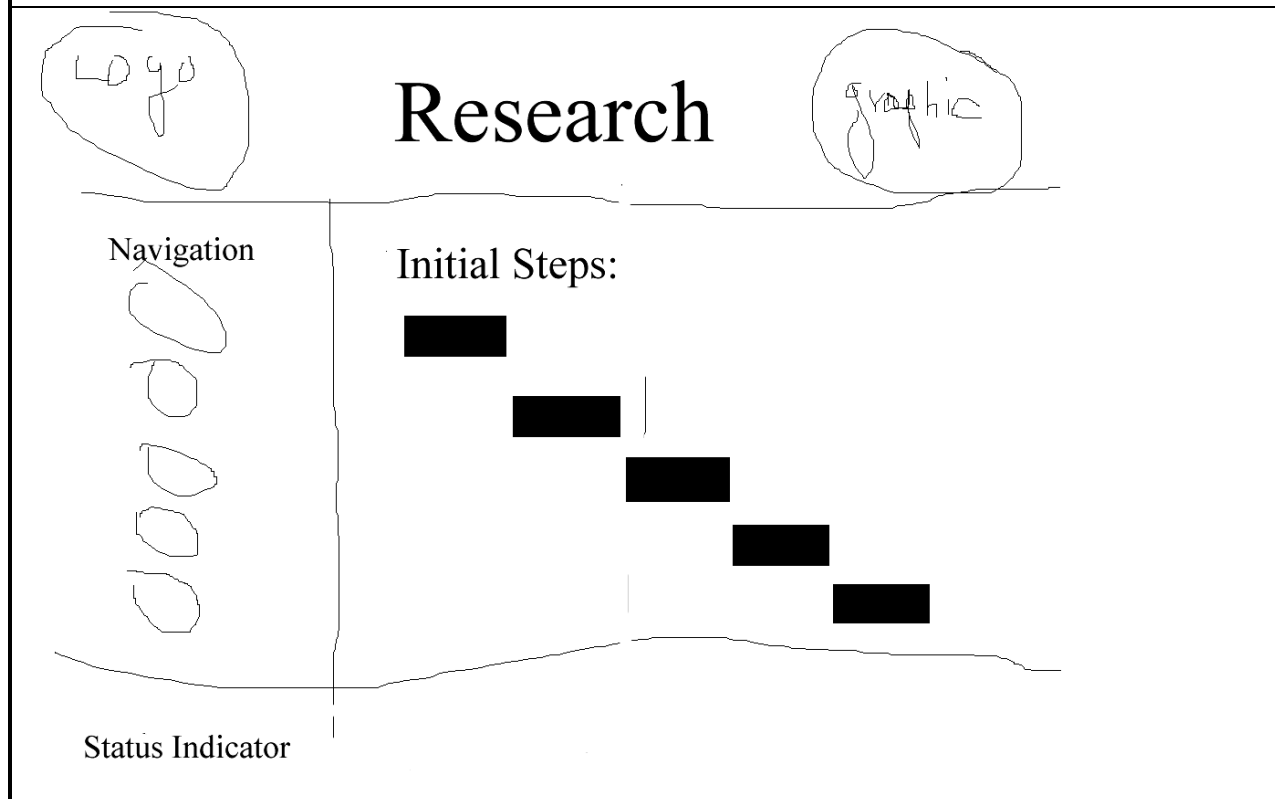


Number of the blocks indicates the level designation for the page.

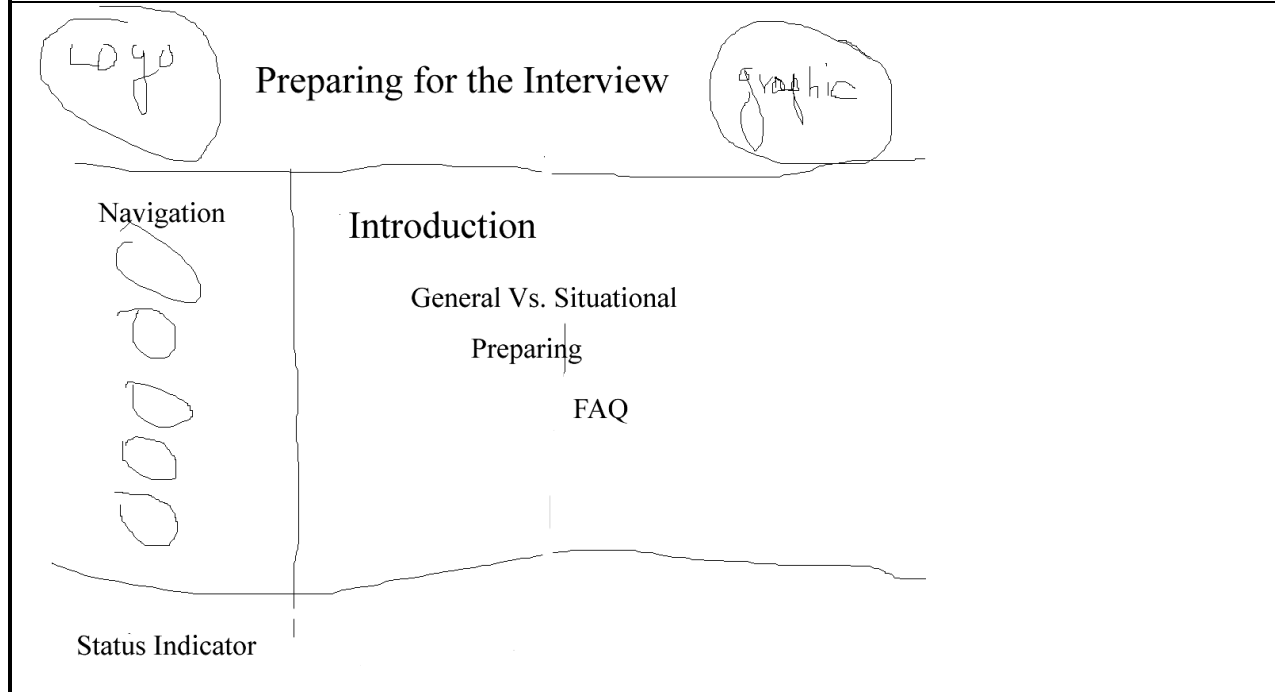

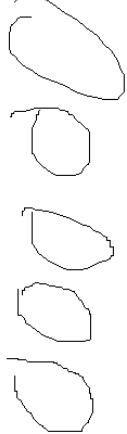
Level 2.0 – Position (position.html)

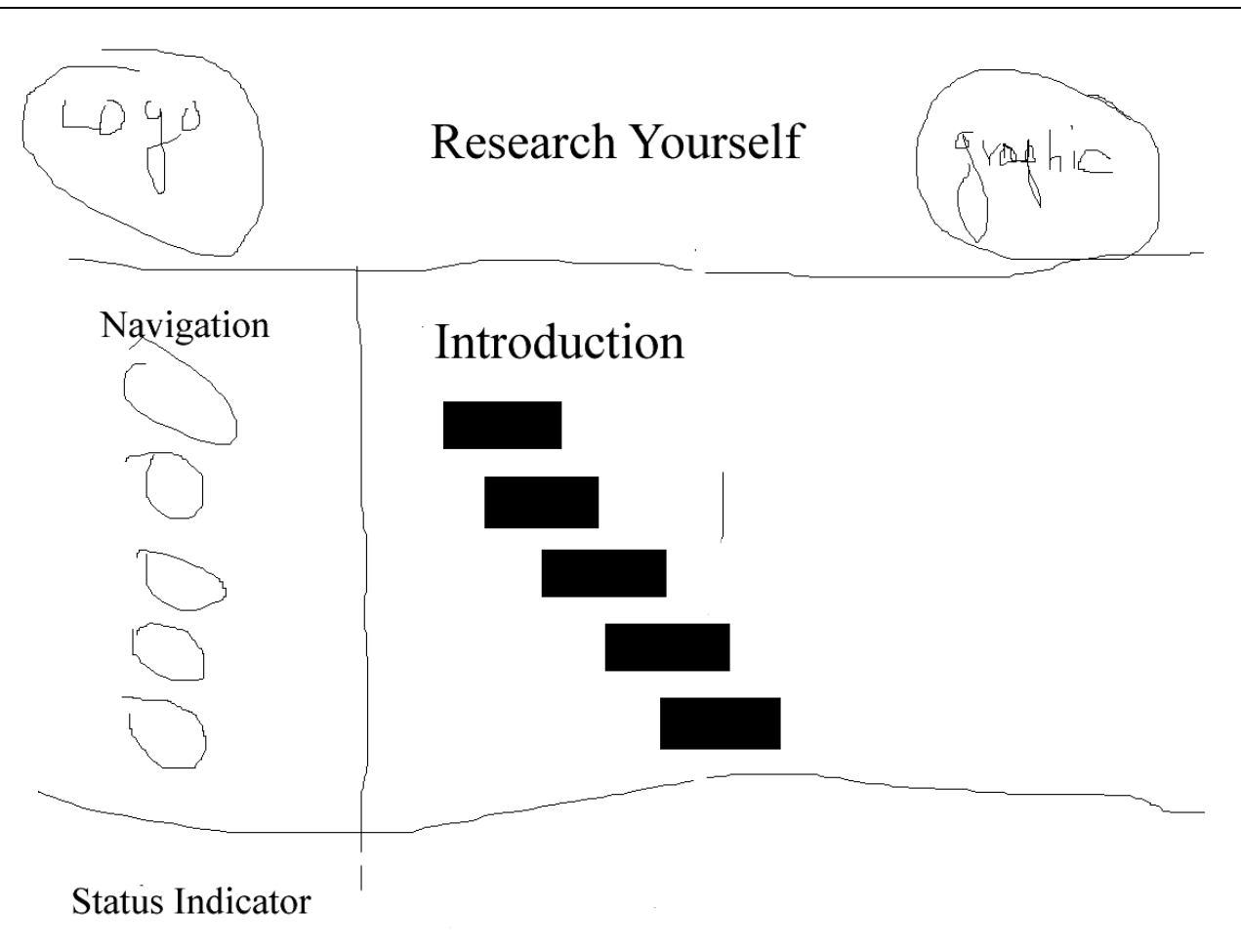

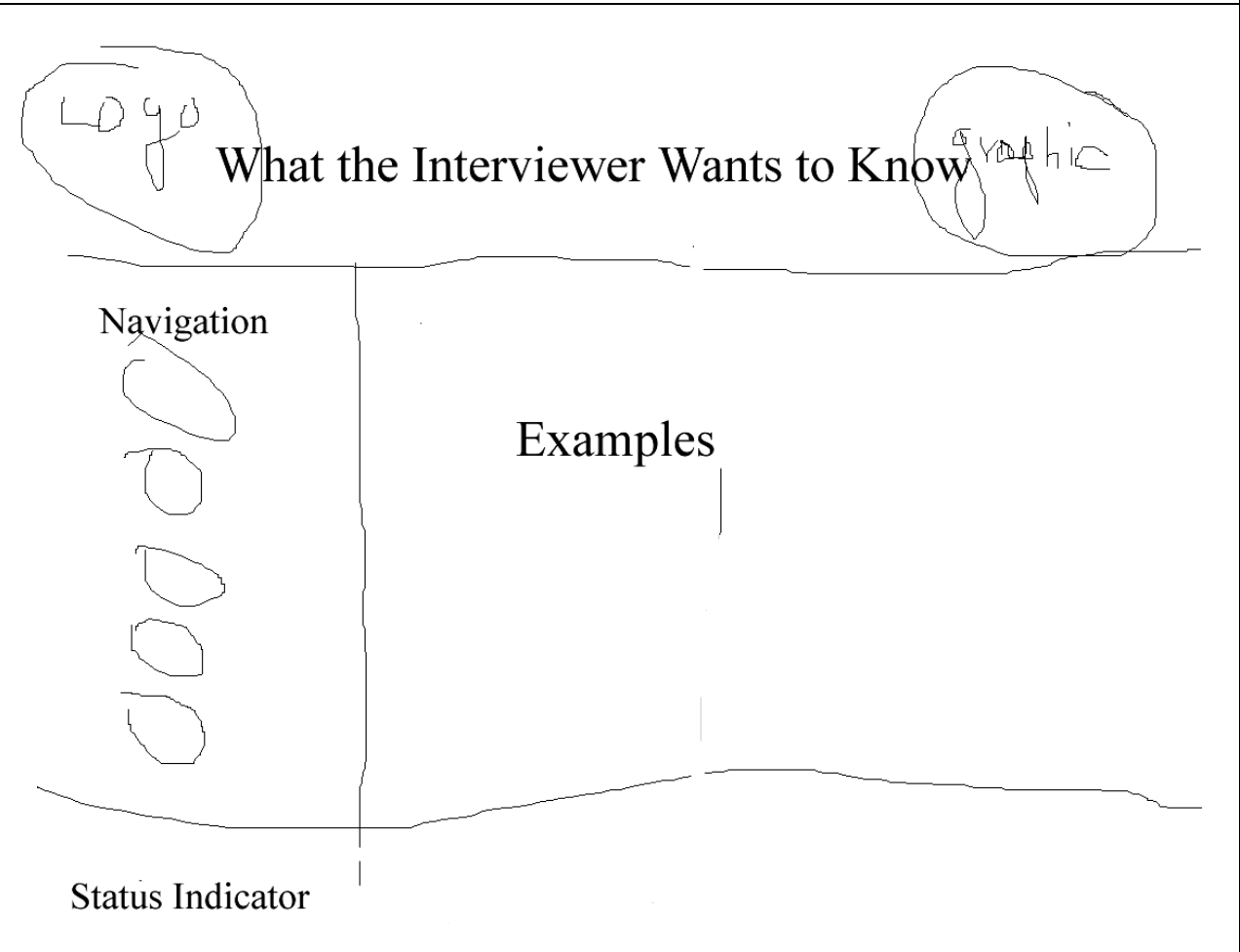
